## **GTT to provide St George with work readiness programs again!**

Gateway To Training is delighted that the 2018 year is shaping up to be exciting and productive once again with a number of programs again being funded and supported by the Commonwealth Government. The professional team at GTT is focused on teaching and inspiring their clients in many areas to assist them into the workforce.

GTT's skilled and experienced staff in St George and Roma are delivering the Commonwealth Government's Transition to Work (TtW) programme across both regions and also in Goondiwindi, Warwick and Stanthorpe.

TtW is an intensive pre-employment support programme that assists 15 to 21 year olds to improve their work readiness skills and gain entry level qualifications. GTT's specialised youth workers provide individual and flexible assistance to help the young people overcome their personal barriers and address their employment concerns.

The Get Set for Work and Steady Ready Go! programs which are funded under the Queensland Government's Skilling Queenslanders for Work initiative is again being delivered in St George. This is certainly a bonus for the region and GTT is anticipating a keen and enthusiastic response from prospective clients and encourages people to seek advice on how they can be assisted into these free programs. Project Officers in St George Kerry Gorring and Barry Boland are there to help in any way they can.

The Get Set for Work program is an integrated training and pre-employment program for 15 to 19 year olds and will provide a great opportunity and alternative pathways into employment and or training and education for a number of young people.

The Steady Ready Go! program also delivers tailored support and assistance to participants of all ages to help them gain nationally recognised skills and qualifications.

GTT staff also liaise with local employers to assist them to recruit work ready entry level staff as well as connect them to support services including potential wage subsidies and incentives.
