Gateway To Training (GTT) is delighted that 2017 is shaping up to be another exciting year with the continuation of their highly successful work readiness programs across the region.

GTT is once again delivering the Australian Government's Transition to Work (TtW) programme in Goondiwindi, St George, Roma, Warwick and Stanthorpe. TtW is an intensive pre-employment support programme that assists 15 to 21 year olds to improve their work readiness skills and gain entry level qualifications. GTT's specialised youth workers provide individual and flexible assistance to help the young people overcome their personal barriers and address their employment concerns.

Across the Goondiwindi and Balonne regions GTT is also delivering the Get Set for Work and Steady, Ready, Go! programs which are funded under the Queensland Government's Skilling Qlders for Work initiative.

GTT's Get Set for Work program is an integrated training and pre-employment program for 15 to 19 year olds. In 2017 it will provide 40 young people with an alternative pathway into employment and/or training and education.

The Steady Ready Go! program delivers tailored support and assistance to participants of all ages to help them gain nationally recognised skills and qualifications. In 2017 GTT will work with 60 participants from across the Balonne and Border Rivers regions to help them gain a Certificate III qualification as well as work readiness skills.

GTT staff also liaise with local employers to assist them to recruit work ready entry level staff as well as connect them to support services including potential wage subsidies and incentives.
