Get Set for Work

Queensland legislation requires all young people to stay in education or training until they complete Year 12; obtain a Certificate II vocational qualification; turn 17; or have a full time job.

WHAT DOES *Get Set for Work* OFFER?

- Support to complete Certificate II Workplace Skills
- Structured work readiness program
- Employability and life skills
- Assistance to gain employment
- Literacy and numeracy support
- Work experience

The Get Set for Work program provides skills and knowledge to help 15- 19 year olds gain sustainable employment. It offers a range of accredited and non-accredited training and practical skills including work experience.

Limited places are available and applicants will be required to undertake an application and selection process to meet the eligibility requirements

MANDATORY ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- Aged between 15 and 19 years
- Queensland resident
- Not at school, trainee or apprentice
- Not registered with a *jobactive* provider for less than 6 months
